We encourage all students to join us at the audition; no experience is necessary, just a willingness to learn!

#### Broadway Babies Audition (Ages 5-6) May 16th | 4:00pm-5:00pm

All current Broadway Babies, and those new to Elevate, will have a lighthearted and fun "audition" structure similar to what a regular class would look like. They will learn a portion of a song, and a dance, and then will "audition" as a group, but if some students want to try their audition solo, we will also provide the opportunity at the end of class. The song will be a familiar Disney song that we will sing together in class with call and response method so those who are still working on their reading skills can easily participate.

#### Ages 7+ May 16th | 5:00pm - 8:00pm

Please prepare:

- A one minute cut of a Musical Theatre song.
- A one minute monologue.
- A short dance.

\*\*All materials will be sent prior to prospective students, and students will CHOOSE ONE song & monologue from a list of options. A video of a short dance will be provided. All students must learn these materials on their own, PRIOR to the audition.

#### **CLASS REQUIREMENTS**

All classes will take place at Balance Dance Studios; please make sure your performer arrives with: appropriate dance attire, hair pulled back, water bottle, and snack.

\*Classes can be replaced with other Balance Dance Studios' classes, per Director approval. If your performer already takes other classes for another company, additional classes do not need to be added.

# Frequently Asked Questions

Your Students are Growing; the Company should too! We see the passion our students have for the arts and the opportunities they yearn to be a part of! In order to get there, we must "elevate" our practices to guide them to achieve those goals!



"Why do my students have to take an additional dance class?

**Don't they dance during the rehearsal?"** Yes! However, we want our students to become the best triple threats they can be. That requires dance technique class to be taken outside of rehearsals to learn the basics, strengthen their bodies to avoid injury, and build upon skills they can offer while in production rehearsals.

#### "My student only wants to do two musicals a year. What is the Winter Revue?"

A revue is a type of multi-act, popular theatrical entertainment that combines music, dance, and sketches. We will be able to learn all of the necessities to put on a full-scale musical such as acting through a song, ensemble collaboration, as well as working on material from musicals we could not otherwise do/don't have access to the rights (i.e. Wicked, Mean Girls, HAMILTON!!).

Requirements

#### Elevate Binder

Each student will be provided a ringed binder at the Elevate Summer Intensive with the following items:

- Some sheet protectors
- Notebook paper
- A pencil and highlighter

These binders will be a safe place to keep all scripts and song sheets that we will use in class. We buy the rights to each musical we perform; therefore, your performer will also receive an official script to take home for their spring musical.

#### **Mandatory Extra Rehearsals**

Extra rehearsals will take place closer to show time; these dates will be released at the beginning of the year, and all students must be in attendance. Please note that, while we try to plan ahead of time, circumstances may necessitate additional rehearsals after original rehearsals are posted.

#### **Team Building/Retreat**

Our retreat will take place on June 4th. This is a mandatory day of fun for all of our company to bond and kick start the season with our new team! Fee includes all food and activities for the day.

#### Communication

Company members will receive all important information via the Elevate email and Band App. We ask that all parents (and students if allowed) join Band App and include their full name with picture.

Fall/Spring Requirements

#### MINIMUM COMPANY REQUIREMENTS

All students are committed to one full year with the Elevate Company, June 2023– May 2023, with the following minimum requirements:

#### Broadway Babies Fall Rehearsal Time: Tuesday 5pm-6pm

#### Act 1 Fall Rehearsal Times: Tuesday 5pm-7pm

#### Act 2 & Act 3 Fall Rehearsal Times: Tuesday 5pm-8pm



All members of Elevate Performance Company are **required** to take an additional dance class, preferably jazz, outside of Elevate rehearsal to ensure growth of technique, stamina, and strength at Balance Dance Studios. Failure to uphold these requirements could result in removal of company members.

#### **Mandatory Extra Rehearsals**

Extra rehearsals will take place closer to show time; these dates will be released at the beginning of the year, and all students must be in attendance.

Summer Requirements

ALL ELEVATE (INCLUDING BROADWAY BABIES)

#### **BOOST YOUR TRAINING THIS SUMMER!**

Mandatory Summer Intensive: The Elevate Performance Company intensive will take place Aug 7-11th, from 11:00am-3:30pm, at Balance Dance Studios. This is required for all Elevate Company Members (including Broadway Babies. who will have an abbreviated schedule).

**Optional (but highly recommended) Summer Workshop:** Musical Theater Workshop (100 Years of Disney) Tue to Thur, June 6-8, 12:30–2:30pm (does not include Broadway Babies)

#### **Required Summer Class:**

Take ONE weekly class at Balance (or total 8 hours). Does not have to be consecutive. Taking the Musical Theater Workshop: 100 Years of Disney could apply to these hours (this is 9 hrs total).
